AN ACT

RELATING TO GAMBLING; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE CRIMINAL
CODE TO PROVIDE FOR BINGO OPERATIONS BY SENIOR CITIZEN GROUPS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Criminal Code, Section
30-19-7.2 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"30-19-7.2. [NEW MATERIAL] RECREATIONAL BINGO
EXCEPTION. -- Nothing in this chapter or in the New Mexico Bingo
and Raffle Act prohibits a senior citizen group from organizing
and conducting bingo at a senior citizen center, provided that
no person other than players participating in the bingo game
receive or become entitled to receive any part of the proceeds,
either directly or indirectly, from the bingo game, and no minor
is allowed to participate in the organization or conduct of
games or play bingo. As used in this section, "senior citizen

2 membership consists of persons who are at least fifty-five years
3 of age and the primary activities and purposes of which are to
4 provide recreational or social activities for those persons. "
