19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million seven
21	hundred thousand dollars ($\$1,700,000$) when the department of
22	environment certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
23	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
24	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner
25	possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been

1 developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 2 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 3 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 5 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are amended. 6 appropriated to the department of environment for the purpose of designing and constructing a city effluent line to provide 7 recycled water in Las Vegas located in San Miguel county. 8 Any 9 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 10 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the department of environment has not certified the need for 11 12 the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 13 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
