AN ACT

RELATING TO COURTS; REQUIRING A DISTRICT COURT JUDGE IN THE SEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT TO RESIDE IN AND MAINTAIN HIS PRINCIPAL OFFICE IN SIERRA COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 34-6-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1968, Chapter 69, Section 13, as amended) is amended to read:

"34-6-10. JUDGES--SEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.--There shall be three district judges in the seventh judicial district. The judge of division three shall reside in and maintain his principal office in Sierra county."

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is January 1, 1998.
