Section 1. APPROPRIATION--PROGRAMS.--Two million four  
hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000) is appropriated from the  
general fund to the department of health for expenditure in  
fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of funding statewide human  
immunodeficiency virus support services, including medications,  
advocacy, housing, complementary and Native American therapies  
and insurance assistance; prevention programs, including peer-  
based outreach, targeted populations capacity building, behavior  
change support, groups, counseling and testing; and provider  
education and an information network. Any unexpended or  
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998
