MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO INCREASE CHILD-SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT IN
NORTHWESTERN NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars
(\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human
services department for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the
purpose of contracting with the Navajo nation to provide
increased child-support enforcement in northwestern New Mexico.
Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
