AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CERTAIN TRANSPORTATION FUNDS FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION-RELATED SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-8-26 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 76, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-8-26. TRANSPORTATION DISTRIBUTION. --

A. Money in the transportation distribution of the public school fund shall be used only for the purpose of making payments to each school district for the to and from school transportation costs of students in grades kindergarten through twelve attending public school within the school district and of three- and four-year-old children who meet the state board approved criteria and definition of developmentally disabled and

1 for transportation of students to and from their regular
2 attendance centers and the place where vocational education
3 programs are being offered.

4 B. In the event a school district's transportation
5 allocation exceeds the amount required to meet obligations to
6 provide to and from transportation, three- and four-year-old
7 developmentally disabled transportation and ~~[vocation]~~
8 vocational education transportation, the district shall ~~[revert]~~
9 use the remaining transportation funds ~~[to the transportation~~
10 ~~distribution in the department]~~ for other transportation-related
11 services. The district shall submit a report to the department
12 regarding expenditures for other transportation-related services
13 pursuant to Section 22-8-29 NMSA 1978.

14 C. In the event the sum of the proposed
15 transportation allocations to each school district exceeds the
16 amounts in the transportation distribution, the allocation to
17 each school district shall be reduced in the proportion that the
18 local school district allocation bears to the total statewide
19 transportation distribution.

20 D. Local school boards, with the approval of the
21 state transportation director, may provide additional
22 transportation services ~~[pursuant to Section 22-16-2 NMSA 1978]~~
23 to meet established program needs. "

3 A. Prior to November 15 of each year, each local
4 school board of a school district shall report to the state
5 transportation director, upon forms furnished by the state
6 transportation director, the following information concerning
7 the district's operation on the fortieth day of school:

8 (1) the number and designation of school bus
9 routes in operation in the school district;

10 (2) the number of miles traveled by each school
11 bus on each school bus route, showing the route mileage in
12 accordance with the type of road surface traveled;

13 (3) the number of students transported on the
14 fortieth day of school;

15 (4) the projected number of students to be
16 transported in the next school year;

17 (5) the percentage of unpaved or unimproved
18 roads [~~utilized~~] used by school buses in the school district;
19 [~~and~~]

20 (6) the seating capacity, age and mileage of
21 each bus [~~utilized~~] used in the district for student
22 transportation; and

23 (7) the prior year's expenditures for other
24 transportation-related services made from remaining
25 transportation funds.
