AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION; AMENDING THE
CALCULATION OF THE TRANSPORTATION ALLOCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-8-29.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1995,
Chapter 208, Section 10, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-8-29.1. CALCULATION OF TRANSPORTATION ALLOCATION. --

A. The department [~~of education~~] shall calculate the
transportation allocation for each school district in the
following manner:

(1) group [~~total~~] school districts on the basis
of the average square miles served per student transported in
the prior year;

(2) in each group, calculate the prior year's
average operational expenditure per student transported in each

1 district;

2 (3) calculate the average for the group by
3 taking the total prior year's expenditure for the group and
4 dividing it by the number of students in the group;

5 (4) multiply the group average operational
6 expenditure per student by the number of students transported on
7 the fortieth day of the current year. Designate the product
8 "A";

9 (5) add "A" to the mileage supplement. The sum
10 of "A" and the mileage supplement is "B";

11 (6) for the 1995-96 [~~and the 1996-97~~] through
12 the 1999-2000 school years, "B" shall not be less than
13 ninety-five percent or more than one hundred fifteen percent of
14 the district's previous year's operational allocation, provided
15 that if "B" is less than ninety-five percent, "B" is deemed to
16 equal ninety-five percent and if "B" is greater than one hundred
17 fifteen percent, "B" is deemed equal to one hundred fifteen
18 percent. Calculate "B" accordingly; and

19 (7) multiply "B" by the transportation
20 distribution adjustment factor.

21 [~~B. For the 1997-98, 1998-99 and 1999-2000 school~~
22 ~~years, the transportation allocation for each school district~~
23 ~~shall not be less than ninety-five percent or more than one~~
24 ~~hundred fifteen percent of the 1996-97 school year's~~
