AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL
CODE PERTAINING TO STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN INTERSCHOLASTIC
EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-12-2.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1986,
Chapter 33, Section 27, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-12-2.1. INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES--
STUDENT PARTICIPATION. --

A. A student shall have a 2.0 grade point average on
a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent, either cumulatively or for the
grading period immediately preceding participation, in order to
be eligible to participate in any interscholastic
extracurricular activity. For purposes of this section,
"grading period" is a period of time not less than six weeks.

1 The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to special
2 education students placed in class C and class D programs.

3 B. No student shall be absent from school for
4 school-sponsored interscholastic extracurricular activities in
5 excess of fifteen days per semester, and no class may be missed
6 in excess of fifteen times per semester.

7 C. The provisions of Subsections A and B of this
8 section apply [~~to all~~] only to interscholastic extracurricular
9 activities.

10 D. The state superintendent may issue a waiver
11 relating to the number of absences for participation in any
12 state or national competition. The state superintendent shall
13 develop a procedure for petitioning cumulative provision
14 eligibility cases, similar to other eligibility situations.

15 E. Student standards for participation in
16 interscholastic extracurricular activities shall be applied
17 beginning with a student's [~~second semester of grade eight~~]
18 academic record in grade nine."
