AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAYS; REQUIRING THE STATE HIGHWAY AND
TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO INSTALL VEHICLE IMMOBILIZERS ON
INTERSTATE HIGHWAY EXIT RAMPS TO OBSTRUCT VEHICLES FROM ENTERING
THE WRONG WAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. VEHICLE IMMOBILIZERS--DUTIES.--The state
highway and transportation department shall install vehicle
immobilizers on all interstate exit ramps to prevent vehicles
from entering interstate highways the wrong way. As used in
this section, "vehicle immobilizer" means any device engineered
to obstruct or immobilize a vehicle traveling in the wrong
direction and may include tire shredders triggered by a
direction detection monitor.
