AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO EXPAND AND ENHANCE PROGRAMS AT THE AGRICULTURAL SCIENCE CENTER IN FARMINGTON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty-one thousand dollars (\$151,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of expanding and enhancing cooperative extension service programs at the agricultural science center in Farmington. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred twenty-four thousand dollars (\$324,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for

expenditure in fiscal year 1998 to expand and enhance agricultural experiment station programs at the agricultural science center in Farmington. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
