AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR  
THE SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONVERTING FIVE  
TERM EMPLOYEES TO FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred seventy-six  
thousand eight hundred dollars (\$176,800) is appropriated from  
the general fund to the district attorney's office for the  
second judicial district for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for  
the purpose of converting five term employees to full-time  
employees. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at  
the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
