17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding two hundred fifty
21	thousand dollars (\$250,000) when the state department of public
22	education certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The
23	state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of
24	the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

1 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 5 6 state department of public education for the purpose of constructing a vocational complex to provide classroom and 7 laboratory space at Santa Rosa consolidated schools located in 8 9 Guadalupe county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 10 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 11 severance tax bonding fund. If the state department of public 12 education has not certified the need for the issuance of the 13 bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided 14 in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
