MANNY M ARAGON

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE NATIONAL STATUARY HALL; CREATING A STATUARY HALL  
COMMISSION; HONORING POPAY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. COMMISSION CREATED. --The "statuary hall  
commission" is created. The commission shall be composed of no  
more than nine persons, the chairman of which shall be the  
governor and the membership of which shall include the state  
treasurer, the state cultural affairs officer, the executive  
director of the New Mexico office of Indian affairs and no fewer  
than four members appointed by the governor from a list of names  
that have been submitted to him by the Indian nations, tribes or  
pueblos in New Mexico, containing names of members of those  
Indian nations, tribes or pueblos who would be appropriate to

1 serve on the commission. Terms of the members shall extend  
2 until a second statue from New Mexico is emplaced in the  
3 national statutory hall in Washington, D.C. The governor shall  
4 fill any vacancy on the statutory hall commission within three  
5 months from the date that the vacancy occurs in the same manner  
6 as original members were appointed.

7 Section 2. DUTIES. --The statutory hall commission shall:

8 A. meet at the call of the governor but shall meet  
9 no fewer than four times per year;

10 B. determine the process necessary for New Mexico to  
11 have a second statue placed in the national statutory hall;

12 C. develop procedures for the funding of the second  
13 statue and raise funds to commission the design, creation and  
14 transport of a statue to be placed in the national statutory hall  
15 through the creation of a foundation for the acceptance of  
16 gifts, donations, bequests and proceeds from appropriate  
17 fundraising events in accordance with the provisions of the act  
18 of July 2, 1864 (40 U.S.C. 187); and

19 D. commission the design and creation of a statue of  
20 the illustrious San Juan pueblo Indian strategist and warrior  
21 Popay, who was renowned, respected and revered by the Native  
22 Americans of New Mexico as the leader of the pueblo revolt of  
23 1680 and who would be the second Native American to be honored  
24 with placement of a statue in the national statutory hall.

25 Section 3. APPROPRIATION. --Sixty thousand dollars

1 (\$60,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office of  
2 cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998  
3 for the purpose of paying mileage and per diem expenses pursuant  
4 to the Per Diem and Mileage Act to members of the statutory hall  
5 commission that are not official representatives of state  
6 agencies and to pay for operational expenses of the commission.  
7 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
8 fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

9 Section 4. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public  
10 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
