AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR STATE-TRIBAL LEGAL INSTITUTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of creating quarterly state-tribal legal institutes that would discuss and identify solutions to outstanding issues of concern to the state and the Indian nation, tribes and pueblos located in New Mexico. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
