MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW MEXICO
STATE UNIVERSITY TO ERADICATE THE COTTON BOLL WEEVIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure
in fiscal year 1998 to contract for services for field surveys
and trapping necessary to eradicate the cotton boll weevil
throughout the state's cotton production area. Any unexpended
or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998
shall revert to the general fund.
