AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR THE CLUSTER TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR VARIOUS PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN BERNALILLO COUNTY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS-- PURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED-- APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS. --

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding five hundred seventy-nine thousand five hundred seventy dollars (\$579,570) when the state department of public education certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most

1 expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the  
2 board that the project has been developed sufficiently to  
3 justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to  
4 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance  
5 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply  
6 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The  
7 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the  
8 state department of public education in the following amounts to  
9 purchase and install computer, telecommunications and electrical  
10 support infrastructure in the following public schools in  
11 Bernalillo county:

- 12 (1) seventy-six thousand four hundred fifty-  
13 five dollars (\$76,455) for Cochiti elementary school;
- 14 (2) twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) for  
15 Garfield middle school;
- 16 (3) fifty-seven thousand seven hundred five  
17 dollars (\$57,705) for Griegos elementary school;
- 18 (4) seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) for La  
19 Luz elementary school;
- 20 (5) seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) for Los  
21 Duranes elementary school;
- 22 (6) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for  
23 MacArthur elementary school;
- 24 (7) sixty-two thousand one hundred ten dollars  
25 (\$62,110) for Mission Avenue elementary school;

1 (8) ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) for  
2 Reginald Chavez elementary school; and

3 (9) fifty thousand three hundred dollars  
4 (\$50,300) for Valley high school.

5 B. If the state department of public education has  
6 not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end  
7 of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section  
8 shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
9 from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to  
10 Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year 2000  
11 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

12 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
13 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
