1 board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to 2 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 3 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 4 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the local government division for the purpose of purchasing heavy 7 equipment for Carrizozo located in Lincoln county. 8 Any 9 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 10 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the local government division has not certified the need for 11 12 the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 13 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
