AN ACT

RELATING TO WELFARE REFORM; PROVIDING THAT LEGAL IMMIGRANTS AND UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS RECEIVE CERTAIN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SOCIAL AND EDUCATION SERVICES-- PROVIDED TO LEGAL AND UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS. --

A. Legal immigrants shall be eligible to receive the following services and programs from the state:

- (1) medicaid;
- (2) temporary assistance to needy families;
- (3) Title 20 social services;
- (4) state and federal child care assistance;

and

(5) women, infants and children nutrition programs and other commodity benefits.

Section 1. SOCIAL AND EDUCATION SERVICES-- PROVIDED TO
LEGAL AND UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS. --

A. Legal immigrants shall be eligible to receive the
following services and programs from the state:

- (1) emergency medical and health services;
- (2) Title 20 social services;
- (3) state child care assistance;
- (4) women, infants and children nutrition
programs and other commodity benefits; and
- (5) child and adult care food programs.

B. Undocumented immigrants shall be eligible to

1 receive health services from the state.

2 C. Immigrants may participate in the child and adult
3 care food program administered by the children, youth and
4 families department. The state shall opt out of enforcing
5 immigration restrictions on participation in the program.
