AN ACT

RELATING TO TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES; REGARDING  
FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. DECLARATION OF LEGISLATIVE INTENT.--It is the  
intent of the legislature that executive agencies implementing  
the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation  
Act of 1996 shall not exceed the minimum participation rates,  
the sanction requirements or extend the scope of prohibited acts  
as set forth in that act.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
