BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. JOB TRAINING PROGRAMS--RECIPIENTS OF TEMPORARY
ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES--PREFERENCE.--Until July 1, 2000,
all state job training programs, including apprenticeship
programs, in-plant training and federal Job Training Partnership
Act programs, shall give preference to recipients of temporary
assistance for needy families, unless prohibited by federal law
or when such preference is inconsistent with federal
requirements for obtaining funding for the job training program.
