AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL
FINANCE ACT TO MANDATE PROGRAM-BASED BUDGETING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-8-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
Chapter 16, Section 63, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-8-9. BUDGETS-- MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS. --

A. No budget for a school district shall be approved
by the department that does not provide for:

(1) a school year consisting of at least one
hundred eighty full instructional days or the equivalent
thereof, exclusive of any release time for in-service training;
or

(2) a variable school year consisting of a
minimum number of instructional hours established by the state

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1 board; and

2 (3) a pupil-teacher ratio or class or teaching
3 load as provided in Section 22-2-8.2 NMSA 1978; and

4 (4) effective July 1, 1997, a full-time,
5 department-certified nurse for each fifty-five teachers employed
6 by a school district or the equivalent part-time, department-
7 certified nurse for less than fifty-five teachers.

8 B. No budget for a school district shall be approved
9 by the department that does not provide for a program-based
10 budget for each school in the district and for the district as a
11 whole.

12 [~~B.~~] C. The state board shall, by regulation,
13 establish the requirements for a teaching day, the standards for
14 an instructional hour and the standards for a full-time
15 certified classroom instructor and for the equivalent thereof.

16 [~~C.~~] D. The local school board shall submit a plan
17 for the implementation of an alternate school year to the state
18 superintendent for his approval.

19 [~~D.~~] E. The provisions of Subsection [~~C.~~] D. and
20 Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of this section shall be construed
21 to apply only to school districts with a MEM of one thousand or
22 fewer. "

23 Section 2. APPLICABILITY. -- The provisions of this act
24 apply to budgets for fiscal year 1999 and subsequent fiscal
25 years.

RELATING TO EDUCATION; DEVELOPING PROGRAM-BASED BUDGETING;
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. NEW MATERIAL PROGRAM-BASED BUDGETING. --

A. The state department of public education shall facilitate the development of procedures for the implementation of program-based budgeting for each school in a school district.

B. Participants in the development shall be school district business managers and representatives of the association of school business officials.

C. An interim status report for fiscal year 1998 shall be provided to the legislative education study committee.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state
