MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE INCENTIVES FOR NATIONAL
NATIVE AMERICAN ORGANIZATIONS TO HOLD CONFERENCES IN NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Sixty thousand dollars
(\$60,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New
Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year
1998 for the purpose of providing incentives for national Native
American organizations to hold conferences in New Mexico. Any
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
