SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES AVAILABLE TO NATIONAL GUARD
RETIREES; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 66-3-413 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1980,
Chapter 45, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-3-413. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES. --

A. The division shall issue distinctive registration
plates to any person who is [~~a~~] an active or retired member of
the New Mexico national guard, upon the submission by the person
of proof satisfactory to the division that he is [~~currently a~~]
an active or retired member of the guard. No fee shall be
collected for issuance of a special registration plate pursuant

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to this section.

B. No person shall falsely represent himself to be an active or retired member of the New Mexico national guard so as to be eligible to be issued special registration plates pursuant to this section when he in fact is not [~~a-current~~] an active or retired member of the New Mexico national guard.

C. Any person who violates the provisions of Subsection B of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor."
