AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS; PROMOTING CAMPAIGN COST REDUCTION BY  
SHORTENING THE PERIOD FOR EARLY VOTING BY TEN DAYS; AMENDING A  
SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 1-6A-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,  
Chapter 37, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"1-6A-5. PROCESSING APPLICATION. --

A. The county clerk shall mark each completed  
absentee-early application with the date and time of receipt in  
the clerk's office and enter the required information in the  
absentee ballot register.

B. If the applicant has no valid affidavit of  
registration on file in the county and he is not a federal  
qualified elector, he shall not be allowed to vote. The county

1 clerk shall mark the application "rejected" and file the  
2 application in a separate file from those accepted.

3 C. If the applicant presents proof of identification  
4 and is determined to be a voter or a federal qualified elector,  
5 the county clerk shall mark the application "accepted" and  
6 deliver a marksense ballot or allow the voter to vote on the  
7 direct-recording electronic machine. Upon acceptance of the  
8 application, an appropriate designation shall be made on the  
9 absentee register.

10 D. Absentee-early voting may be done in person  
11 during the regular hours of business at the county clerk's  
12 office or other locations specified by the county clerk;  
13 provided that in class A counties, the county clerk shall  
14 establish not less than four alternative locations as satellite  
15 polling places. Absentee-early voting may be done from 8:00  
16 a.m. on the [~~twentieth~~] tenth day preceding the election up  
17 until 5:00 p.m. on the Saturday immediately prior to the date of  
18 the election. In voting absentee-early, the voter may be  
19 assisted by one person of the voter's own choice.

20 E. The secretary of state and county clerk shall  
21 make reasonable efforts to publicize and inform voters of the  
22 times and locations for absentee-early voting. "
