AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH; CHANGING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 24-2B-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1989, Chapter 227, Section 6) is amended to read:

"24-2B-6. CONFIDENTIALITY. -- No person or the person's agents or employees who require or administer the test shall disclose the identity of any person upon whom a test is performed or the result of such a test in a manner which permits identification of the subject of the test, except to the following persons:

A. the subject of the test or the subject's legally authorized representative, guardian or legal custodian;

B. any person designated in a legally effective

1 release of the test results executed prior to or after the test
2 by the subject of the test or the subject's legally authorized
3 representative;

4 C. an authorized agent, a credentialed or privileged
5 physician or employee of a health facility or health care
6 provider if the health care facility or health care provider
7 itself is authorized to obtain the test results, the agent or
8 employee provides patient care or handles or processes specimens
9 of body fluids or tissues and the agent or employee has a need
10 to know such information;

11 D. the department of health [~~and environment~~
12 ~~department and the centers for disease control of the United~~
13 ~~States public health service~~] in accordance with reporting
14 requirements [~~for a diagnosed case of acquired immune deficiency~~
15 ~~syndrome~~] established by regulation;

16 E. a health facility or health care provider which
17 procures, processes, distributes or uses:

18 (1) a human body part from a deceased person,
19 with respect to medical information regarding that person;

20 (2) semen provided prior to the effective date
21 of the Human Immunodeficiency Virus Test Act for the purpose of
22 artificial insemination;

23 (3) blood or blood products for transfusion or
24 injection; or

25 (4) human body parts for transplant with

2 F. health facility staff committees or accreditation
3 or oversight review organizations which are conducting program

7 who may not further disclose any identifying characteristics or
8 information; and

9 H. for purposes of application or reapplication for
10 insurance coverage, an insurer or reinsurer upon whose request
11 the test was performed. "
