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| 15 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: |
| 16 | Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS |
| 17 | APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS |
| 18 | A. The state board of finance may issue and sell |
| 19 | severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding |
| 20 | Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts |
| 21 | authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 5 of |
| 22 | this act. The state board of finance shall schedule the |
| 23 | issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and |
| 24 | economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the |
| 25 | project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance |
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and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 5 of this act.

B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 5 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.

C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.

D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 through 5 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the department of environment that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the department of environment for the following purposes:

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A. four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to develop and construct a municipal water supply and sewage disposal system at Acoma located in Cibola county; and

B. two million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$2,800,000) for improvements to the water system and purchase of a water storage tank at Acomita lake located in Cibola county.

Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the local government division of the department of finance and administration that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the local government division for the following purposes:

A. six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to construct a multipurpose recreational facility in the city of Grants located in Cibola county;

B. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to purchase three vans equipped with wheelchair lifts and lockdowns for the Bethphage mission in the city of Grants located in Cibola county; and

C. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design, construct and make improvements to First street, Second street and Roosevelt street in the city of Grants located in Cibola county.

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Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--NEW MEXICO OFFICE OF INDIAN AFFAIRS--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the New Mexico office of Indian affairs that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for the following purposes:

A. one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to renovate the domestic water distribution system at San Jose valley on the pueblo of Laguna located in Cibola county; and

B. three million two hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000) to construct gas distribution lines to the villages of Encinal and Paguate on the pueblo of Laguna located in Cibola county.

Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state department of public education that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to the state department of public education for the purpose of purchasing computers, printers, electronic imaging and video equipment for Grants schools and other Cibola county schools.

Section 6. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
