AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO  
FUND COMMUNITY-BASED TRAINING PROGRAMS IN MORA AND SAN MIGUEL  
COUNTIES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand  
dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
labor department for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998  
for the purpose of establishing community-based training  
programs to teach at-risk youths from Mora and San Miguel  
counties traditional building practices and skills in the  
restoration of historic buildings in those counties. Any  
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
