AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING THE CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR RECEIVING OR TRANSFERRING A STOLEN MOTOR VEHICLE; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 66-3-505 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 92) is amended to read:

"66-3-505. RECEIVING OR TRANSFERRING STOLEN VEHICLES OR MOTOR VEHICLES. --Any person who, with intent to procure or pass title to a vehicle or motor vehicle ~~which~~ that he knows or has reason to believe has been stolen or unlawfully taken, receives or transfers possession of the ~~same~~ vehicle or motor vehicle from or to another or who has in his possession any vehicle ~~which~~ that he knows or has reason to believe has been stolen or unlawfully taken and who is not an officer of the law engaged
