AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CLARIFYING THE PURPOSE AND  
EXTENDING THE EXPENDITURE PERIOD OF A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION  
FOR A SOUTHSIDE COMMUNITY CENTER IN HOBBS; MAKING AN  
APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND--CLARIFYING THE PURPOSE--EXTENDING  
EXPENDITURE PERIOD--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the general  
fund appropriation made pursuant to Subsection SSSSS of  
Section 24 of Chapter 222 of Laws 1995 to design, construct,  
furnish and equip a southside community center in Hobbs in Lea  
county shall be expended to design, construct, furnish and equip  
a southside senior citizen center and multipurpose center in the  
city of Hobbs. The period of time for expenditure of the  
appropriation is extended through fiscal year 2000. Any

1 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
2 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the general fund.

3 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
4 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
