AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY  
OF NEW MEXICO FOR SPECIAL PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars  
(\$595,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of  
regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in  
fiscal year 1998 for the following projects in the following  
amounts:

(1) three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000)  
for recruitment of academically exceptional graduate students to  
improve the quality and quantity of research work done at the  
university of New Mexico; and

(2) two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars

1 (\$295,000) for the art of the Americas institute to conduct  
2 teaching, research and public service projects and promote  
3 cultural diversity in the arts.

4 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
5 at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
