AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A DEMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE EAST MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY IN PORTIONS OF BERNALILLO, SANDOVAL, TORRANCE AND SANTA FE COUNTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of conducting a demographic study of the East Mountain community located in portions of Bernalillo, Sandoval, Torrance and Santa Fe counties for the purpose of researching data resources, collecting and compiling relevant data and producing a comprehensive report for existing and prospective residents and businesses to use in planning.
