AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CHANGING THE PURPOSE AND  
EXTENDING THE EXPENDITURE PERIOD OF A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION  
FOR A HEALTH CLINIC IN ARTESIA IN EDDY COUNTY; MAKING AN  
APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
ADMINISTRATION--CHANGING THE PURPOSE--EXTENDING EXPENDITURE  
PERIOD--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the general fund  
appropriation made to the local government division of the  
department of finance and administration pursuant to Subsection  
JJ of Section 6 of Chapter 147 of Laws 1994 for designing,  
planning, constructing, equipping and furnishing a community  
health clinic in the city of Artesia located in Eddy county  
shall not be expended for its original purpose but is

1 appropriated to the local government division for designing,  
2 planning, constructing, equipping or furnishing a community  
3 health clinic, including the option of upgrading to a modular  
4 building, in the city of Artesia in Eddy county. The period of  
5 time for expenditure of the appropriation is extended through  
6 fiscal year 1999. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
7 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the  
8 general fund.

9 Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public  
10 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
