A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE UNINCORPORATED VILLAGE OF LINCOLN BE DESIGNATED AS A SPECIAL HISTORIC DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the unincorporated village of Lincoln is currently designated as a historic district; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the unincorporated village of Lincoln are interested in moving toward self-determination with respect to their community; and

WHEREAS, the current mechanisms that could be used to obtain self-determination over their community are unacceptable; and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated village of Lincoln does not meet the requirements for a special assessment district, and incorporation into a municipality carries too many burdens; and

WHEREAS, the designation of the unincorporated village of

Lincoln as a special historic district is necessary to preserve the historic character and integrity of the district; and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated village of Lincoln is a unique, historic treasure deserving the protection and support of the state to ensure its continued existence as a historic district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the unincorporated village of Lincoln be designated as a special historic district; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the board of commissioners of Lincoln county.
