A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE CREATION OF AN INTERIM ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO
STUDY THE PLAN, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND COST OF A MEMORIAL
HONORING NEW MEXICO WARTIME VETERANS TO BE LOCATED IN SANTA FE.

WHEREAS, New Mexicans have served with extraordinary
distinction in numerous armed conflicts, including World War I,
World War II, the Korean conflict, the Vietnam war, the Persian
Gulf war and interventions in Somalia, Haiti and Bosnia as well
as other conflicts and interventions; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe, our state capital, does not have a
memorial honoring New Mexico wartime veterans; and

WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe has indicated a desire to
donate land for the construction of a memorial honoring New
Mexico wartime veterans; and

WHEREAS, numerous veterans' groups and associations support

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this interim advisory committee
9 report its findings and recommendations to the legislative
10 finance committee and to the local government division of the
11 department of finance and administration by October 31, 1997;

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
14 transmitted to the New Mexico legislative council, to the
15 legislative finance committee and to the local government
16 division of the department of finance and administration.
