#### A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES LEADERSHIP TO ESTABLISH
A SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE TO REVIEW THE LEVEL OF SERVICES
PROVIDED BY THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT TO THE
ADULT COMMUNITY IN NEED OF PROTECTIVE SERVICES AND TO OVERSEE
THE MANNER IN WHICH ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED.

WHEREAS, in 1989 the legislature recognized that some members of the adult population of the state were in need of services because they were unable to manage their own affairs or to protect themselves from exploitation, abuse or neglect; and

WHEREAS, the Adult Protective Services Act was enacted to address the problems recognized by the legislature; and

WHEREAS, the adult protective services program was moved administratively to the children, youth and families department in the early 1990s from the human services department; and

WHEREAS, since that time the program has had twelve staff positions reassigned to perform duties not related to providing adult protective services; and

WHEREAS, providing adult protective services is evidently not a priority within the children, youth and families department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that a subcommittee
of the house of representatives be appointed by the house
leadership to review and assess the implementation of the Adult
Protective Services Act; and

with reviewing the attendant care program and the adequacy of training received by the adult protective services workers; determining if the adult abuse prevention unit should be moved to the protective services division of the children, youth and families department; and assessing the progress of the children, youth and families department in improving facility investigations to ensure accurate and timely reporting of client exploitation, abuse and neglect at facilities in the state, the need for guardians for incapacitated adults and for cooperative efforts between and the adequacy of staffing of the department of health, the state agency on aging and the protective services division as those agencies provide services to adults and developmentally disabled individuals who are in need of

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protective services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the subcommittee identify issues regarding the provision of protective services to adults that can be resolved by legislation and develop the necessary legislation to resolve those issues; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the subcommittee report at each future session of the legislature on its progress and the need to continue in its work; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the leadership of the house of representatives for their consideration and action.
