A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE CITY OF SANTA FE REGARDING THE ACQUISITION BY SANTA FE OF CATHEDRAL PARK.

WHEREAS, the property control division of the general services department wants to sell Cathedral park, located at the corner of east Palace avenue and Cathedral place; and

WHEREAS, the city of Santa Fe has declared in resolution number 1997-14 its desire to acquire the property; and

WHEREAS, the city has maintained the park since at least 1978; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of its long-term investment in the care and upkeep of the park, the city has requested that the state negotiate the transfer of the park to the city so that the city may direct the development of downtown Santa Fe; and

2 reach a mutually agreeable solution that includes the transfer
3 of ownership of Cathedral park to the city;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the general services department be
6 requested to work with the city of Santa Fe in planning the
7 future of Cathedral park, located on the corner of east Palace
8 avenue and Cathedral place with the objective being the
9 acquisition of the park by the city; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the general services department
11 report on progress of its discussions with the city of Santa Fe
12 to the appropriate interim legislative committee by December 1,
13 1997; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
15 transmitted to the secretary of general services and the mayor
16 of Santa Fe.
