2 **43RD LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO- FIRST SESSION 1997**
3 INTRODUCED BY
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10 A JOINT MEMORIAL

11 REQUESTING NEW MEXICO'S PUBLIC POST-SECONDARY TWO- AND FOUR-YEAR INSTITUTIONS TO PROVIDE A BROAD RANGE OF
12 INSTRUCTION, SPECIAL PROGRAMS, RESEARCH AND SPECIAL PROJECTS.

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14 WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislature has supported a broad range of instructional and related
15 services at public post-secondary two- and four-year institutions; and

16 WHEREAS, it is the clear intent of the New Mexico legislature that basic programs and research and
17 public service projects be continued; and

18 WHEREAS, boards of regents of constitutionally created post-secondary institutions are authorized by
19 the constitution of New Mexico to establish budgets; and

20 WHEREAS, public post-secondary two- and four-year institutions are required to submit to the
21 commission on higher education operating budgets that reflect legislative intent and specific appropriations;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the block
23 appropriations to public post-secondary two- and four-year institutions contained in the General
24 Appropriation Act of 1997 shall be reviewed by the commission on higher education and certified to the
25 legislative finance committee and the department of finance and administration to be consistent with the
