### A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM RECOGNIZE THE CONTRIBUTION TO UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATION MADE BY TEACHING ASSISTANTS AND RESEARCH ASSISTANTS.

WHEREAS, the institutions of higher education in the state have many graduate students in a variety of programs; and

WHEREAS, many of those graduate students are employed, by contract, with the university as teaching assistants or research assistants to provide tenured professors with assistance on academic projects, and to teach lower-level curricula to undergraduate students; and

WHEREAS, these students are generally employed for the entire academic year for a salary of about eight thousand dollars (\$8,000), making it difficult to obtain health insurance, at a time when many graduate students who are

teaching assistants or research assistants are married and have families; and

WHEREAS, the university does not include health benefits in any contractual agreements with these students, who provide the university a large savings by teaching classes that qualified faculty members would have to teach but for their presence, at a cost much, much greater to the university than an annual eight thousand dollar (\$8,000) stipend;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it support efforts to provide graduate students across the state who are either teaching assistants or research assistants at their respective institutions of higher education with health insurance benefits, either paid in full by the university or with some contribution toward the policy also made by those students; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the issue of health insurance benefits for graduate students who are teaching assistants or research assistants be reviewed by all institutions of higher education in the state who employ these students, and that the status of this issue be reported to the appropriate interim legislative committee no later than October 1, 1997; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent to the presidents of the university of New Mexico, New Mexico state university, New Mexico institute of mining and technology, western New Mexico university, eastern New Mexico university and
