A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT CHILDPROOF SAFETY DEVICES BE DESIGNED INTO OR REQUIRED FOR FIREARMS.

WHEREAS, it is recognized that a firearm is a dangerous weapon and extremely hazardous when in the possession of a child; and

WHEREAS, the safety and protection of children is one of the highest priorities of the state, and essential to order and progress in society; and

WHEREAS, a child is more likely than an adult to mishandle a firearm, with potentially fatal or grave consequences; and

WHEREAS, parents should take responsibility to ensure the safety of their children; and

WHEREAS, a requirement that firearms be designed and manufactured with childproof safety devices would be a major

step in guarding the safety of our children; and

WHEREAS, the design and retrofitting of existing firearms with childproof safety devices is entirely possible if society has the will to require this policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the congress of the United States be requested to require all manufacturers of firearms to produce only weapons that have built-in childproof safety devices; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these same manufacturers be requested to design and market childproof safety devices that can be retrofitted to firearms; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all retailers of firearms in New Mexico be requested to express to the firearms industry the need for childproof safety devices to retrofit existing firearms and for the availability from manufacturers of only firearms that include childproof safety devices; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be sent to each firearms retailer in New Mexico listed with the bureau of alcohol, tobacco and firearms of the United States department of the treasury.
