AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO FOR
HEALTH CARE AND MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two million fifty-seven thousand one hundred
dollars (\$2,057,100) is appropriated from the general fund to
the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for
expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the following purposes:

(1) one million six hundred fifty-seven
thousand one hundred dollars (\$1,657,100) for intensive
psychiatric treatment and related services for children and
adolescents through age seventeen provided by the children's
psychiatric hospital;

(2) two hundred fifty thousand dollars

1 (\$250,000) for operational expenses at Carrie Tingley
2 hospital; and

3 (3) one hundred fifty thousand dollars
4 (\$150,000) for operational expenses of the office of the
5 medical investigator.

6 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
7 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the
8 general fund.
