

SENATE CAPITAL OUTLAY REQUEST 470

FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS IN MEADOWLAKE IN VALENCIA COUNTY.

I request that the following capital outlay project be funded:

- to the state highway and transportation department:
  - A. forty-four thousand dollars (\$44,000) to blade, shape, compact prime and pave a portion of Journey road in Meadowlake in Valencia county;
  - B. thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000) to blade, shape, compact prime and pave a portion of Amy road in Meadowlake in Valencia county;
  - C. forty-eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$48,500) to blade, shape, compact prime and pave a portion of Turner road in Meadowlake in Valencia county;
  - D. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to blade, shape, compact prime and pave a portion of Dairy road in Meadowlake in Valencia county; and
  - E. three hundred thirty-four thousand dollars (\$334,000) to blade, shape, compact prime and pave a portion of the Manzano expressway in Meadowlake in Valencia county; and
- from the New Mexico irrigation works construction fund

to the state engineer:

four hundred ninety-six thousand dollars (\$496,000) to make improvements to the ditch lining of the irrigation system, including extending or installing irrigation pipe as needed, at the Bluewater-Toltec irrigation district in Cibola county.
