WHEREAS, both civilian and military employees of Holloman air force base reside in Alamogordo and contribute heavily to the local tax base of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it request the United States air force to reconsider the proposed reductions at Holloman air force base in Alamogordo; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of the air force, the secretary of defense and the New Mexico congressional delegation.
