## A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION RECOGNIZE
THAT ATHLETIC TUITION WAIVERS ARE AVAILABLE TO BOTH CITIZENS
OF THE UNITED STATES AND CITIZENS OF ANY FOREIGN COUNTRY.

WHEREAS, nonresident student tuition waivers are commonly used for nonresident students who receive resident status for the purpose of tuition payment; and

WHEREAS, tuition waiver programs that allow nonresident students to pay resident student rates at the state's post-secondary educational institutions have existed in state law since 1970; and

WHEREAS, the term "resident student" includes a student who receives an athletic scholarship from a post-secondary educational institution for the purpose of tuition payment and budget and revenue calculations; and

WHEREAS, the legislature funded athletic tuition waivers at one hundred percent in Chapter 116, Laws of 1998; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico commission on higher education deals with financial issues for post-secondary educational institutions and is concerned with the financing of those institutions and with the equitable distribution of available funds among them;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the commission on higher education be requested to recognize that athletic tuition waivers are available to both citizens of the United States and citizens of any foreign country and that budget and revenue calculations reflect this beginning with appropriations made for the fiscal year 1999; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the president of each post-secondary educational institution designated in Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico and to the executive director of the New Mexico commission on higher education.
