AN ACT

RELATING TO MILITARY SERVICE; ENACTING THE SELECTIVE SERVICE  
REGISTRATION AWARENESS AND COMPLIANCE ACT; REQUIRING THAT  
EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE COMPLY WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE  
REQUIREMENTS; REQUIRING THAT STUDENTS AT PUBLIC POST-SECONDARY  
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS COMPLY WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE  
REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. [NEW MATERIAL] SHORT TITLE. -- This act may be  
cited as the "Selective Service Registration Awareness and  
Compliance Act".

Section 2. [NEW MATERIAL] LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. -- The  
legislature finds that the federal act requires all persons to  
register with the selective service system. The legislature  
further finds that the federal act limits eligibility for

1 federal student financial assistance and eligibility for  
2 employment within the executive branch of the federal  
3 government to persons who are in compliance with the  
4 requirements of the federal act.

5 Section 3. [NEW MATERIAL] DEFINITIONS. --As used in the  
6 Selective Service Registration Awareness and Compliance Act:

7 A. "federal act" means the federal Military  
8 Selective Service Act; and

9 B. "person" means a male citizen of the United  
10 States or a male who resides in the United States who is  
11 eighteen years of age or older and who is not a lawfully  
12 admitted non-immigrant alien.

13 Section 4. [NEW MATERIAL] EDUCATION--FINANCIAL AID--  
14 STATE EMPLOYMENT. --

15 A. A public post-secondary educational institution  
16 shall not enroll any person who is not in compliance with the  
17 federal act.

18 B. A person who is not in compliance with the  
19 federal act shall not be eligible for employment by or service  
20 with the state, including its executive agencies, political  
21 subdivisions, boards and commissions, institutions and  
22 instrumentalities.

23 C. The state shall be responsible to ensure  
24 compliance with the federal act for any person who:

25 (1) is enrolled in a public post-secondary

2 (2) receives financial aid at a public post-  
3 secondary educational institution; or

4 (3) is hired to work for the state.

5 D. A person shall not be denied a right, privilege  
6 or benefit under the Selective Service Registration Awareness  
7 and Compliance Act if:

8 (1) pursuant to the federal act, the person's  
9 requirement has terminated or become inapplicable; or

10 (2) the person has served in the armed  
11 services or has a condition that precludes his acceptability  
12 for military service.
