AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PURCHASES; AMENDING PROCUREMENT CODE
EXCLUSIONS FROM CENTRAL PURCHASING REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 13-1-99 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984,
Chapter 65, Section 72, as amended) is amended to read:

"13-1-99. EXCLUDED FROM CENTRAL PURCHASING THROUGH THE
STATE PURCHASING AGENT. -- Excluded from the requirement of
procurement through the state purchasing agent but not from
the requirements of the Procurement Code are the following:

A. procurement of professional services;

B. small purchases having a value not exceeding
~~[two hundred fifty dollars (\$250)]~~ five hundred dollars
(\$500);

C. emergency procurement;
