AN ACT

RELATING TO PURCHASING; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE PROCUREMENT
CODE PERTAINING TO COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT AGREEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 13-1-135 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984,
Chapter 65, Section 108) is amended to read:

"13-1-135. COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT AUTHORIZED. --

A. Any state agency or local public body may
either participate in, sponsor or administer a cooperative
procurement agreement for the procurement of any services,
construction or items of tangible personal property with any
other state agency, local public body or external procurement
unit in accordance with an agreement entered into [~~under the~~
~~Joint Powers Agreements Act~~] and approved by the governing
authority of each of the state agencies, local public bodies

1 or external procurement units involved. The cooperative
2 procurement agreement shall clearly specify the purpose of the
3 agreement and the method by which the purpose will be
4 accomplished. Any power exercised under a cooperative
5 procurement agreement entered into pursuant to this subsection
6 shall be limited to the central purchasing authority common to
7 the contracting parties, even though one or more of the
8 contracting parties may be located outside this state. An
9 approved and signed copy of all cooperative procurement
10 agreements entered into pursuant to this subsection shall be
11 filed with the state purchasing agent. A cooperative
12 procurement agreement entered into pursuant to this subsection
13 is limited to the procurement of items of tangible personal
14 property, services or construction.

15 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A
16 of this section, a cooperative procurement agreement providing
17 for mutually held funds or for other terms and conditions
18 involving public funds or property included in Section 11-1-4
19 NMSA 1978 shall be entered into pursuant to the provisions of
20 the Joint Powers Agreements Act.

21 ~~[B.]~~ C. Central purchasing offices other than the
22 state purchasing agent may cooperate by agreement with the
23 state purchasing agent in obtaining contracts or price
24 agreements, and such contract or agreed prices shall apply to
25 purchase orders subsequently issued under the agreement. "
