15	WHEREAS, the Navajo chapter formerly called Canoncito is
16	located about forty minutes west of Albuquerque and north of
17	interstate 40; and
18	WHEREAS, the name "Canoncito", a Spanish word meaning
19	"little canyon", was bestowed on the residents of that Navajo
20	chapter by President Harry S. Truman and the United States
21	congress when congress recognized the "Canoncito Band of
22	Navajo Indians"; and
23	WHEREAS, the people living in the area known as Canoncito
24	have traditionally called the place where they live
25	To'Hajiilee, or "the place where the water is drawn up"; and

8 WHEREAS, the support of the house of representatives of
9 New Mexico is requested in acknowledging the name change of
10 the Canoncito Navajo chapter to the To' Hajiilee Navajo
11 chapter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it acknowledge the change of name of the Canoncito Navajo chapter to the To'Hajiilee Navajo chapter and acknowledge the effort of the students at To'Hajiilee community high school in working to restore the true Navajo name to their chapter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state change highway and road signs, maps and any other public documents printed by the state to reflect the Navajo chapter of To'Hajiilee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States department of the interior be requested to acknowledge the change of name of the To'Hajiilee chapter of the Navajo Nation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the chapter president of the To'Hajiilee .128941.1
