11	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 4, SECTION 3 OF THE
12	CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE THAT NEW MEXICAN
13	TAXPAYERS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO DOUBLY COMPENSATE LEGISLATORS.

15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 3
17	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
18	"A. Senators shall not be less than twenty-five
19	years of age and representatives not less than twenty-one
20	years of age at the time of their election. If any senator or
21	representative permanently removes his residence from or
22	maintains no residence in the district from which he was
23	elected, then he shall be deemed to have resigned and his
24	successor shall be selected as provided in Section 4 of this
25	article. No person shall be eligible to serve in the

legislature who, at the time of qualifying, holds any office of trust or profit with the state, county or national governments, except notaries and officers of the militia who receive no salary.

B. The senate shall be composed of no more than forty-two members elected from single-member districts.

C. The house of representatives shall be composedof no more than seventy members elected from single-memberdistricts.

D. Once following publication of the official report of each federal decennial census hereafter conducted, the legislature may by statute reapportion its membership.

E. New Mexico taxpayers shall not be required to doubly compensate members of the legislature. A legislator shall not be paid a salary derived from general fund revenues of the state of New Mexico and simultaneously receive per diem or other compensation for legislative service. "

Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection at the next general election or at any special election prior to that date which may be called for that purpose.
