NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the United States bureau of reclamation be requested to recommend privatization of all the lease lots on Elephant Butte and Caballo reservoirs without exception; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the director of the United States bureau of reclamation and to the New Mexico congressional delegation.
