MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES
DEPARTMENT TO CONTRACT FOR EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS, INCLUDING
SHAKEN BABY SIMULATION DOLLS, FOR HOSPITALS AND BIRTHING
CENTERS TO EDUCATE PARENTS OF NEWBORNS TO PREVENT SHAKEN BABY
SYNDROME.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 2017 to contract for educational materials, including shaken baby simulation dolls, for every hospital and birthing center in the state to educate parents of every newborn to prevent shaken baby syndrome before a newborn is discharged from the hospital or birthing center. Any
